Money you can get

You can get 50,000 yen per child.

Who can get the money

Those who fall under either ① or ② below

- ① Those who were unable to receive the Child Rearing Allowance (money to raise a child alone) for April 2022 due to receiving public pensions, etc.
Public pensions include Bereaved family pension (money received when a family member dies), Disability pension (money received by a disabled person), Old-age pension (money received by the elderly), Workmen's accident pension (money received when you get injured or sick at work), Compensation for bereaved family (money received when a family member dies).
- ② Households whose income has decreased since February 2022 due to the impact of the novel coronavirus and has reached the same level as households receiving child rearing allowance (single child rearing expenses)

How to receive money is written on the back

Money received from the country/local community

Money you can get

You can get 50,000 yen per child.

Who can get money

As of March 31, 2022, those who are raising a child under the age of 18 (if a child with a disability, under the age of 20) and fall under either ① or ②.

① Households with low income and do not need to pay resident tax

Families who won't have to pay taxes in year 2021.

② Households whose income has fallen sharply

Households whose income after January 2022 becomes very low due to the impact of the novel coronavirus and is the same as a family that does not need to pay tax.
