Summer Course (Term 1)



1. Course Overview

Starting this year, this Japanese course is offered by the Osaka International House Foundation in cooperation with the JASSO Osaka Japanese Language Education Center. It is for foreign residents or workers in Osaka City and focuses on beginner–intermediate practical conversation. All classes are taught in person by JASSO instructors.

2. Eligibility

For non-Japanese speakers or those wanting to improve daily conversation. Participants must be 16 or older, live or work in Osaka City, and be able to attend all classes.

4. Class Levels and Schedule *Each class holds about 12 students; each day has two 50-min periods.*

Morning	Mon–Fri	10:10 – 12:00	Beginner (3 classes) / Intermediate (1 class)
Afternoon	Mon–Fri	13:10 – 15:00	Beginner (3 classes) / Intermediate (1 class)
Evening	Tues & Thurs	16:10 – 18:00	Beginner (1 class)

Note: Class offerings may change depending on circumstances.

5. Eligibility Requirements

Participants must hold a valid residence status throughout the course.
